

**Anatomy and Physiology Lab Coordinator Instructor**

The Department of Kinesiology at Kansas State University is seeking applicants for a 9-month, full-time Anatomy and Physiology Lab Coordinator position at the Instructor level. The responsibilities are as follows: A) Instruct anatomy & physiology laboratories; B) Supervise and coordinate anatomy and physiology lab instruction and activities; C) Provide academic advising to undergraduate majors in the Department of Kinesiology.

Candidates are required to have a completed Master's degree or equivalent in kinesiology, exercise science or a related area. Candidates are preferred to have two years teaching experience in anatomy & physiology courses and experience with multimedia instructional methods.

The Department of Kinesiology at Kansas State University provides instruction for more than 700 undergraduate majors and more than 50 masters and doctoral students. Kansas State, a member of the Big 12 conference, is a comprehensive land-grant institution with a strong research focus and a growing enrollment of over 24,000. The screening of applicants will begin **October 15, 2015** and continue until the position is filled. Expected start date is January 3, 2016. Salary will be commensurate with experience.
